Explanation of Responses:

1. Represents the value of the Reporting Person's Company Stock Fund Account in the Company's 401(k) plan as of May 31, 2002, expressed as share equivalents. As of such date, approximately 98% of the Company Stock Fund was invested in Company Common Stock, and the remainder was invested in cash.
2. Represents shares of restricted stock granted to the Reporting Person on October 23, 1997 and April 22, 1998 under the Issuer's Long-Term Stock Incentive Plan which may vest over the next three years.
3. Represents shares directly owned by the Reporting Person's son. The Reporting Person disclaims beneficial ownership.
4. Represents amounts allocated to, and the total holdings in, the Reporting Person's Company Stock Fund Account in the Company's Supplemental Savings and Investment Plan as of May 31, 2002, expressed as share equivalents.
5. Represents shares acquired for the Reporting Person's account under the Company's Salary and Bonus Deferral Plan. The shares allocated to the Reporting Person's account on the specified transaction dates were acquired by the plan trustee at various times and prices, resulting in the average prices indicated in the "Price" column.
6. Represents an option granted to the Reporting Person on April 22, 1997 under the Issuer's Long Term Stock Incentive Plan to purchase 5,000 shares of the Issuer's Common Stock at \$18.00 per share.
7. Represents an option granted to the Reporting Person on May 18, 2001 under the Issuer's Omnibus Incentive Compensation Plan to purchase 25,000 shares of the Issuer's Common Stock at \$16.87 per share.

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8. Represents an option granted to the Reporting Person on January 24, 2002 under the Issuer's Omnibus Incentive Compensation Plan to purchase 36,000 shares of the Issuer's common Stock at \$12.24 per share.
