Pursuant to the instructions in Item 7 of Schedule 13G, Fidelity Management & Research Company ("Fidelity"), 82 Devonshire Street, Boston, Massachusetts 02109, a whollyowned subsidiary of FMR LLC and an investment adviser registered under Section 203 of the Investment Advisers Act of 1940, is the beneficial owner of 7,013,217 shares or

14.496% of the Common Stock outstanding of Cogent Communications Group Inc ("the Company") as a result of acting as investment adviser to various investment companies registered under Section 8 of the Investment Company Act of 1940. The number of shares of Common Stock of Cogent Communications Group Inc owned by the investment companies at December 31, 2007 included 202,134 shares of Common Stock resulting from the assumed conversion of \$9,940,000 principal amount of COGENT COMM CV 1% 6/15/27 (20.3355 shares of Common Stock for each \$1,000 principal amount of debenture).

The ownership of one investment company, Fidelity Export & Multinational Fund, amounted to 2,657,356 shares or 5.493% of the Common Stock outstanding. Fidelity Export & Multinational Fund has its principal business office at 82 Devonshire Street, Boston, Massachusetts 02109.

The ownership of one investment company, Fidelity Mid Cap Stock Fund, amounted to 3,400,000 shares or 7.028% of the Common Stock outstanding. Fidelity Mid Cap Stock Fund has its principal business office at 82 Devonshire Street, Boston, Massachusetts 02109.

Edward C. Johnson 3d and FMR LLC, through its control of Fidelity, and the funds each has sole power to dispose of the 7,013,217 shares owned by the Funds.

Members of the family of Edward C. Johnson 3d, Chairman of FMR LLC, are the predominant owners, directly or through trusts, of Series B voting common shares of FMR LLC, representing 49% of the voting power of FMR LLC. The Johnson family group and all other Series B shareholders have entered into a shareholders' voting agreement under which all Series B voting common shares will be voted in accordance with the majority vote of Series B voting common shares. Accordingly, through their ownership of voting common shares and the execution of the shareholders' voting agreement, members of the Johnson family may be deemed, under the Investment Company Act of 1940, to form a controlling group with respect to FMR LLC.

Neither FMR LLC nor Edward C. Johnson 3d, Chairman of FMR LLC, has the sole power to vote or direct the voting of the shares owned directly by the Fidelity Funds, which power resides with the Funds' Boards of Trustees. Fidelity carries out the voting of the shares under written guidelines established by the Funds' Boards of Trustees.
