- (1) The 4,561 shares disposed of reflect 4,044 shares withheld by the issuer to fund the cashless exercise of 6,000 options after the market close on 12/9/2011, and 517 shares withheld by the issuer to cover the associated tax liability.
- (2) Cashless exercise of 6,000 options after the close of the market on December 9, 2011
 - RSU's are equal in value to one share of Common Stock, are issued under the 2008 Equity Plan and acquired under terms of the ProAssurance Corporation 2011 Employee Stock Ownership Plan. The RSUs will vest upon the sooner of three years of continuous employment, termination of employment by reason of death or disability or for "good reason," or a change of control of the Company. If
- (3) a participant terminates employment more than twelve months but less than three years from the date of grant, the RSUs will partially vest based on the number of days that the participant was employed in the vesting period. Any RSUs that are unvested on termination of employment will be forfeited. In addition, if a participant withdraws shares purchased for his or her account, matching unvested RSUs will be forfeited.
